

Last week we quoted the *Shevet Mussar* who brings from *Rishonim* that the concept of, “*k’mayim panim el panim – As water reflects one’s face, does one’s heart reflect another’s,*” also applies between every Jew and Hashem. Therefore, when one focuses on his love of Hashem, it arouses, so to speak, Hashem’s love for him.

We should add that this also provides us with a great way to arouse our own love for Hashem. By focusing on how great Hashem’s love for us is, our own hearts will be aroused to love Him as well.

Imagine the greatest level of love you ever felt for someone in your life. For example, your own child crying out in pain to you or the like. Focus on reliving that scenario and when you do, remember that at that very moment Hashem is overflowing with a much greater love towards us. This visualization will awaken the great love for Hashem that is buried within us as it is within every Jew. For, “*As water reflects one’s face so does one’s heart reflect another’s!*” This will further arouse, so to speak, Hashem’s love for us etc. etc., in a never ending pattern of ever greater love between us and Hashem, fulfilling the very purpose of Creation!
